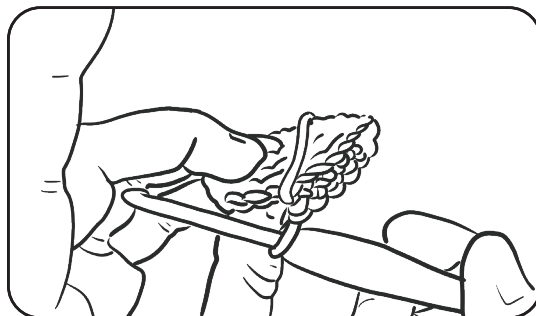
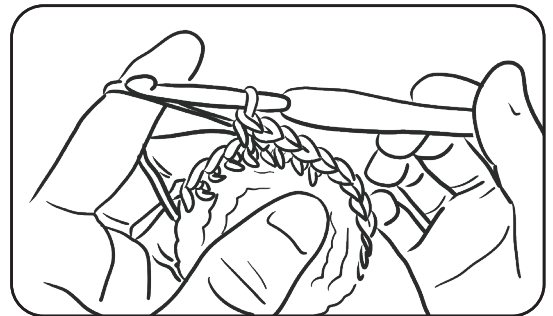
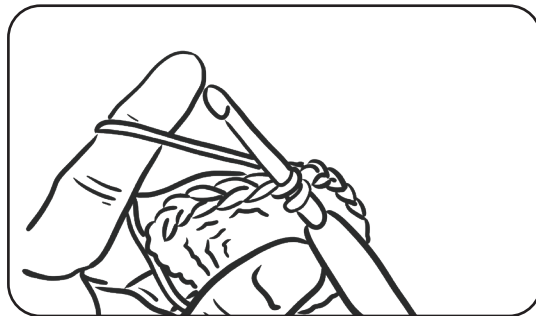
Invisible decrease by putting the hook through the front loops of the next two stitches, then proceeding as though making a single crochet (see image).
